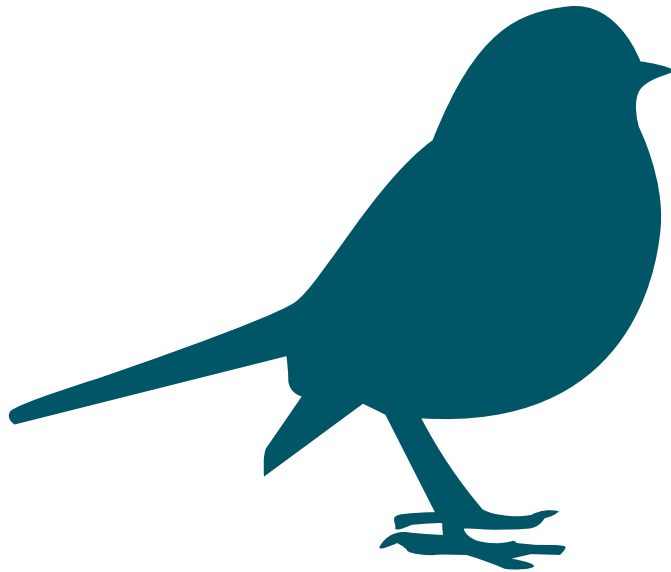

Mae cymryd rhan yn hollol syml

- 1 Cyfrwch yr adar rydych chi'n eu gweld yn eich gardd, ar eich balconi neu yn eich parc lleol am awr rhwng 26 a 28 Ionawr 2024.

Defnyddiwch y blychau cyfri ar draws i helpu i gofnodi a chyfrif yr adar rydych chi'n eu gweld. Trosglwyddwch eich cyfrifon i'r ffurflen canlyniadau. Mae'r siart yma'n dangos rhai o'r adar y gallech eu gweld. Efallai y byddwch chi'n gweld adar eraill, os felly, cofnodwch nhw ar y ffurflen canlyniadau hefyd. Lle nad ydym yn dangos adar gwrywaidd a benywaidd, mae'r ddau ryw yn edrych yn debyg, ond nid ydynt bob amser yn union yr un fath.

- 2 Mae dilyn y rheolau syml hyn yn ei gwneud hi'n hawdd cyfrif yr adar rydych chi'n eu gweld.

Dim ond yr adar sy'n glanio y dylech eu cynnwys, nid y rheini sy'n hedfan drosodd. Cyfrwch nifer uchaf pob rhywogaeth a welwch ar unrhyw un adeg, fel arall gallech gyfrif yr un aderyn ddwywaith. Er enghraifft, os gwelsoch chi grŵp o wyth drudwen, ac ar ddiwedd yr awr rydych chi'n gweld chwe drudwen gyda'i gilydd, ysgrifennwch '8' fel eich cyfrif terfynol.

- 3 Ewch i www.rspb.org.uk/gwylioadar a dywedwch wrthym ni beth welsoch chi.

Taking part is as easy as 1, 2, 3

- 1 Count the birds you see in your garden, from your balcony or in your local park for one hour between 26 and 28 January 2024.

Use the tally boxes on the next page to count and record the birds you spot. Transfer your count to the results form. This chart shows some birds you might see. You may see others, if so record those on the results form too. Where we don't show male and female birds, the sexes look similar, but are not always identical.

- 2 Following these simple rules makes it easy to count the birds you see.

Only include birds that land, not those flying over. Count the highest number of each species you see at any one time, otherwise you could count the same bird twice. For example, if you saw a group of eight Starlings but then towards the end of your hour you saw six together, record '8' as your final Starling count.

- 3 Go online and tell us what you saw at www.rspb.org.uk/birdwatch

Submitting online is quick and easy and it means we can spend more on saving nature as it reduces our costs. Whatever you saw – even if nothing at all – please tell us. The more results we have, the better the picture we will be of how garden birds are faring.

What will you see?

Enjoy an hour in nature and count the birds in your garden, from your balcony or in your local park.

How to record your results

- 1 Count the birds for one hour in your garden, from your balcony or local park **between 26 and 28 January 2024**.
- 2 Record the total for each bird in the boxes on the count chart opposite.
- 3 Count the most birds of a particular species you see at any one time. So, if you see a group of eight Starlings, but later see six together, please write down eight as your final count.
- 4 If you don't see any of the birds on the chart, record '0' as your final count – it's important for us to know which birds are 'no shows'.
- 5 Only include birds that land, not those flying over.
- 6 Even if you saw nothing make sure you tell us, it still counts.
