

Run for Charity – Charity Place Terms & Conditions

By applying for or accepting a charity place through Run for Charity, you agree to the following Terms & Conditions. These apply in addition to any terms set by the event organiser. You must comply with both.



1. Registration & Entry Fees

- Charity places are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.
- You cannot swap, sell or transfer your place in the event or allow anyone to participate on your behalf.
- It is your responsibility to ensure all forms are submitted by the deadline set by the event organiser. RSPB will have no control over race entries after this deadline, and all decisions regarding entry are made by the event organiser after this date.
- If you wish to withdraw your application, you must notify us as soon as possible at CommunityFundraising@rspb.org.uk

2. Fundraising Commitment

- By accepting a charity place, you agree to raise at least the fundraising target stated for your selected event, excluding Gift Aid.
- You must only use legal fundraising methods and comply with Fundraising Regulator guidelines.

3. Donations

- You agree to keep RSPB updated with your fundraising progress and accept that RSPB may ask you to provide a fundraising plan at any time after you have completed registration in the event.
- You must pass on all fundraising associated with your event to RSPB. You can do this through your fundraising page. Please contact us at CommunityFundraising@rspb.org.uk for support regarding cash donations.
- If the event is cancelled, or you decide not to participate in the event, you are responsible for contacting your sponsors to inform them that you are no longer taking part and for confirming with them that they are still happy for the money to be donated to RSPB.

4. Cancellation, Deferral, and Transfers

- Deferrals or transfers may be offered at the charity's discretion.
- Places cannot be transferred after the event organiser's registration deadline.
- If the event is cancelled or postponed by the organiser, the charity is not liable for costs such as travel or accommodation.
- If postponed, your place may be transferred to the new date or a similar event, subject to charity and organiser approval.

- Spectators, including your supporters and family members, attend the event entirely at their own risk. RSPB will not be held liable for any injury or loss suffered by a spectator.

- You agree to represent your charity positively and avoid behaviour that could damage its reputation.
- RSPB may, at its own discretion, withdraw places in the event if it is believed to be in its own best interest to do so.

- All materials must display the correct charity name and registered charity number.
- Collection tins, buckets, and other materials remain the property of the charity and must be returned within 4 weeks of the event.

- You consent to RSPB contacting you via phone or email for any matter relating to your application, and if you're successful, your fundraising and participation in the event.
